Girls on the Run, a 501(c)3 nonprofit, is physical activity-based positive youth development program designed to enhance girls' social, psychological, and physical skills and behaviors to successfully navigate life experiences.

Our unique, research-backed multi-week curriculum includes lessons that help girls improve their competence, confidence, caring, character, connection with others and contributions to community. Each fall and spring season concludes in a celebratory 5K celebration where we recognize a host of community sponsors.

Sponsorship investments from local businesses are instrumental to bringing these transformational programs to nearly 2,000 girls and families each year. They help provide financial aid and ensure our programs remain accessible, inclusive, and that no girl is turned away based on ability to pay.
