This is a key core value of Girls on the Run and something we will continue to focus on in the year to come. This year has been an incredible year of milestones, growth, and intentional focus for Girls on the Run of Northeast Wisconsin.

We celebrated our 10-year anniversary, serving over 4,000 participants since our inception in 2012. We relished our incredible achievement of hosting our largest program season EVER with over 500 participants and 1,100 in attendance at our Celebration 5k presented by Bergstrom Automotive. We distributed 100 pairs of running shoes and 60 sports bras to participants in our fall program thanks to the support of sponsors and community donations. These are some of the remarkable achievements that we celebrated in our 10th year of operation!

In 2022, we continued our commitment and work on inclusion, diversity, equity and access (IDEA). Some of the ways we elevated this work includes offering new resources for coaches and participants through coach stipends, bus transportation to the Celebration 5k, and increased shoe and sports bra support. In addition to these new resources, we also implemented a new organizational strategic plan that embeds IDEA throughout and focuses on inclusion and representation at all levels of our organization. To launch this work our Board of Directors has been learning and growing through workshops and one on ones with our IDEA consultant, Dorothy Enriquez, CEO of the Ellevate Collective. We recognize that these are just small steps toward greater change, but we are committed to this ongoing work at Girls on the Run of Northeast Wisconsin so every person involved in our organization feels valued and has an affirming, inclusive experience!


