Girls on the Run Greater Houston is the local council of Girls on the Run International. We cover Harris, Fort Bend, and Montgomery Counties and have served over 23,000 girls since we hit the ground running in 2001. We are proud to be able to provide financial aid to over 65% of our participants.

What we do

Using an intentional curriculum that integrates physical activity, trained coaches teach girls critical life skills and strategies they can apply to all aspects of their lives.

Why it matters

- Girls' self-confidence begins to drop by age 9
- 50% of girls age 10 to 13 experience bullying such as name calling and exclusion
- Physical activity levels decline at age 10 and continue to decrease throughout adolescence
