Avoid parking hassles at the 5K - consider taking public transportation on race day! Community Transit's newest rapid transit system is the Swift Orange line and it runs from Edmonds College all the way to McCollum Park Park and Ride (with a stop at Mill Creek Town Center)! Swift buses are faster than normal buses, and on race day will be arriving and departing from every stop along their route every 15-20 minutes. If you miss one—another will be by in no time! If you are traveling in a group, consider meeting at the Swamp Creek Park and Ride, Ash Way Park and Ride, or Lynnwood Transit Center and catching the Swift Orange Line headed to McCollum Park Park and Ride. Or you can park at McCollum Park Park and Ride and take a short, easy ride to the Mill Creek Town Center. Either way, exit the bus at the 153rd St SE stop and you'll be right by our 5K Inspiration Station! Be sure to use the crosswalk!

Public transportation is a safe, reliable, and green way to get to this event and we hope you will consider riding to the 5K this year! Be sure to stop by Community Transit's booth after the race to pick up a Youth ORCA card, and learn more about public transportation.
