- Actively serve in this position and attend two GOTRSESPA events per year, either the 5k, a coach training, or a site visit in the spring season.
- Raise an annual give/get total that will be established by YPB. A member's annual give/get may include corporate match, event ticket sales, corporate sponsorship, hosting a GOTR fundraiser, friends and family donations, etc., in addition to a personal contribution that feels meaningful.
