Over 850 girls at 46 schools, parks and Boys & Girls Clubs grew joyful, healthy and confident under the mentorship of 243 dedicated volunteer coaches in 2022. The inaugural 5K Celebration in Elkhart County was a resounding success and will continue in 2023. Because of the generosity of the community, 55% of girls received financial aid ensuring, for the 12th consecutive year, that no girl was turned away from Girls on the Run for inability to afford the registration fee.

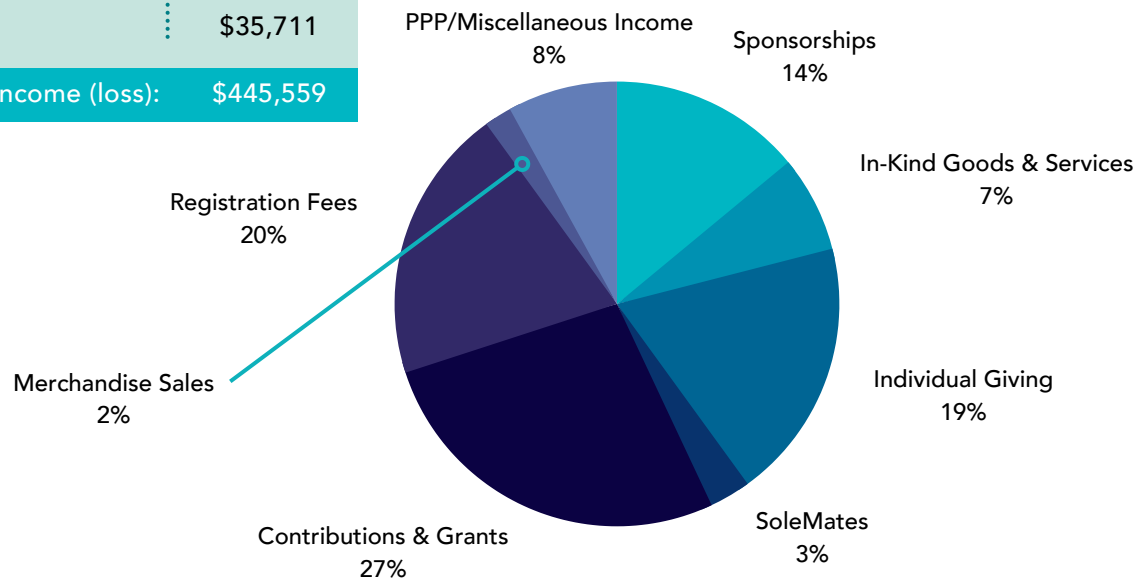
